

WHAT IS PH WINS?

The Public Health Workforce Interests and Needs Survey (PH WINS), the first and only nationally representative survey of state, city, and local public health workers, aims to:

Build the evidence base of training needs




Identify trends in attitudes, morale, and climate



PH WINS PARTICIPATION

- State Health Agencies census
- Big City Agencies census
- Local Health Departments nationally representative sample
 - >25 staff and >25,000 population served
- New for 2021 PH WINS for All Pilot
 - Region V PHTC
 - Region X PHTC





PH WINS 2021

Goal: to be inclusive of the effect of COVID and its response on the workforce, but not to be exclusively about COVID

- Length: Approximately 20 minutes
- Timeline: Launch September 2021
- Sections:
 - 1. Workplace engagement, satisfaction, and intent to leave
 - 2. Training needs
 - 3. Modernization of the workforce
 - 4. Demographics & workforce characteristics



HOW CAN YOUR AGENCY USE PH WINS?

- Include PH WINS metrics in the agency's strategic plan
- Create an agency workforce development plan approved for accreditation
- Provide staff with training the meets their needs and perceived skill gaps
- Institute changes to increase engagement and satisfaction
- Foster a culture of continuous quality improvement
- Inform succession planning and recruitment and retention efforts




PH WINS RESULTS

 Results will be available in the first half of 2022

- Formats/Types
 - Static agency reports*
 - Password protected agency data visualization dashboards*
 - National static reports
 - National data visualization dashboard with ability to look at specific workforce groups

*In order to receive an agency report, your agency must reach the required response rate





RESPONSE RATE REQUIREMENTS

Staff Size	Minimum Response Rate	Approximate # of Respondents
25	94%	24
40	91%	37
50	89%	45
60	87%	53
70	85%	60
80	83%	66
90	81%	73
100	80%	80
200	66%	132
300	56%	168
400+	50%	200+

PH WINS TIMELINE

- 1. Instrument Revisions & Stakeholder Engagement (completed)
- 2. Recruitment (now)
- 3. Pre-Administration (now September 2021)
- 4. Administration (starts September 2021)
- 5. Analysis & Reporting (January July 2022)



ROLE OF THE WORKFORCE CHAMPION

- Serve as the primary point of contact for your agency's participation
 - Identify a secondary point of contact
- Assist in identifying IT point of contact
- Obtain staffing lists for the survey
- Assist with pilot test of survey and initial test emails
- Promote PH WINS 2021 within your agency and encourage participation
- Collaborate with de Beaumont to help ensure the success of PH WINS 2021

- Deadline: August 13, 2021
- Information needed:
 - First name, last name, and email address
 - Additional helpful information: division, position, and/or title*
- Please include*:
 - All public health agency staff
 - Local offices if you are a centralized state
 - Contractors and federal employees working for the agency
- Format: excel spreadsheet
- Additional materials: organizational chart

^{*}If your agency includes divisions beyond public health and you would like them to participate, you MUST provide the division/unit of each staff member. All staff members must still be under the purview of the health official.



ALLOW LISTING

- Deadline: August 27, 2021
- What is it?
 - Allow listing is a process that ensures the survey invitation email does not get caught in spam filters
 - We will work with an IT contact directly to get this done
- Information needed:
 - Name and email address of an IT contact
- You will provide this on the form shared in the follow-up email to this webinar
