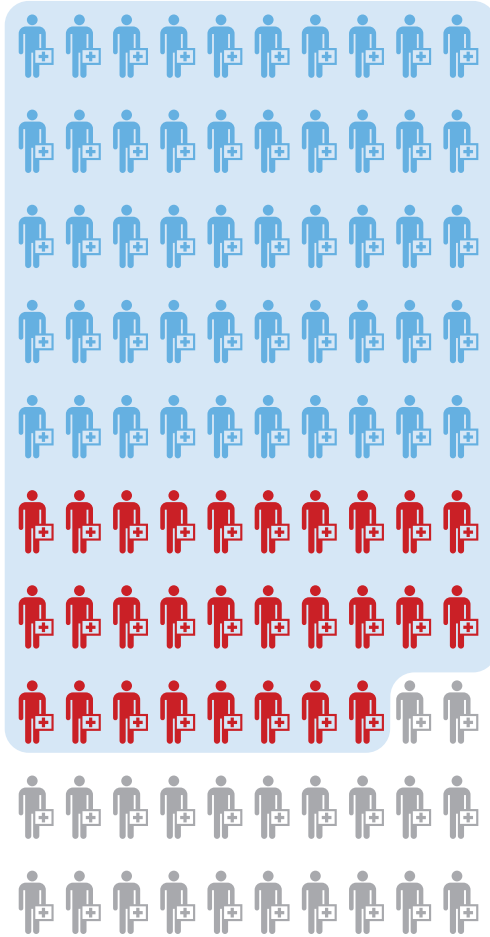


# POLL: DOCTORS NOT PREPARED TO TREAT LONG COVID

Results from a Morning Consult poll of U.S. physicians

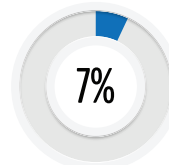
## IS LONG COVID A PROBLEM?



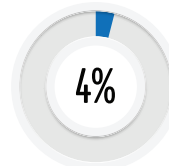
**78%**

On behalf of the de Beaumont Foundation, Morning Consult conducted a national online poll Dec. 9-19, 2022, among a sample of 806 U.S. physicians and Dec. 10-14, 2022, among 2,210 U.S. adults. Results from the physician survey have a margin of error of +/-3%, and results from the full adult sample have a margin of error of +/- 2%.
